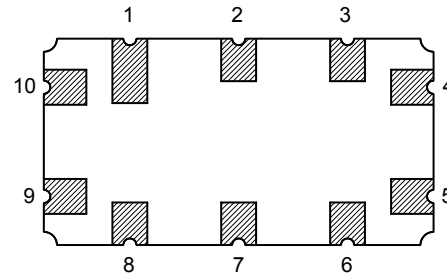

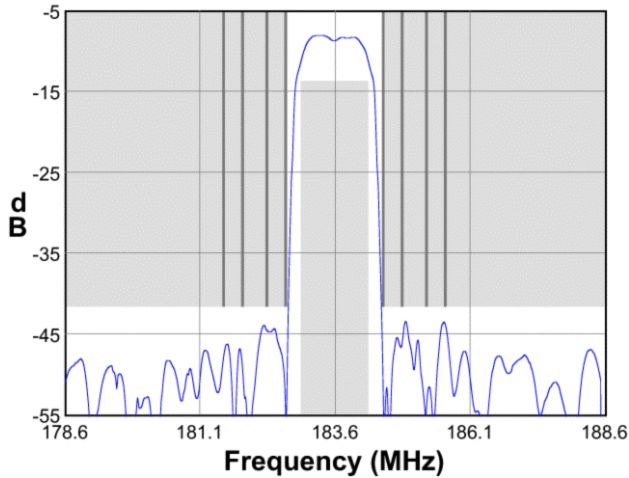

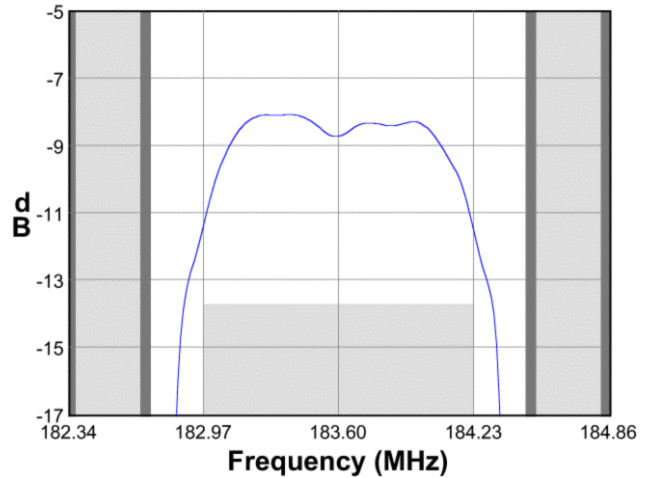

Typical Performance (at +25°C)

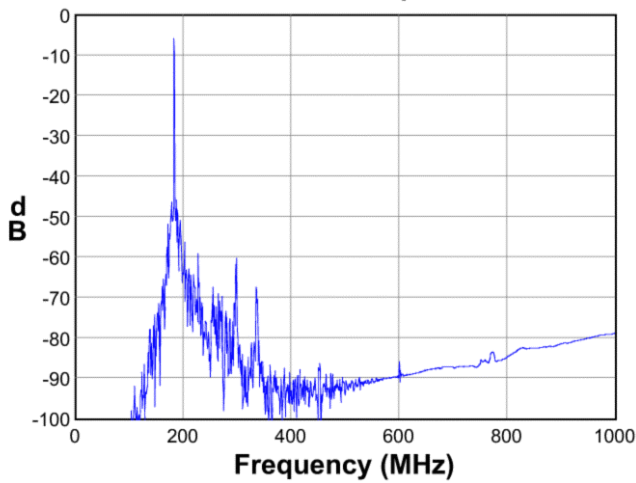
Frequency Response



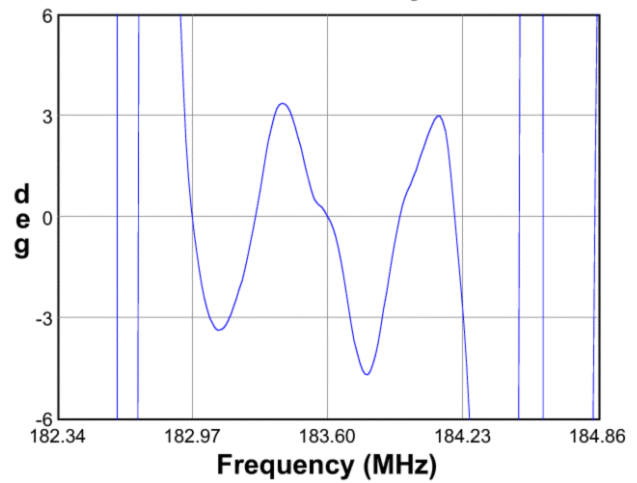
Passband Response



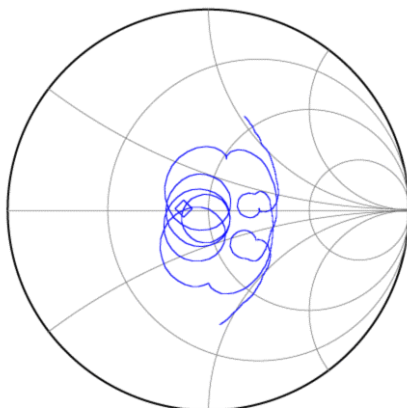
Wideband Response



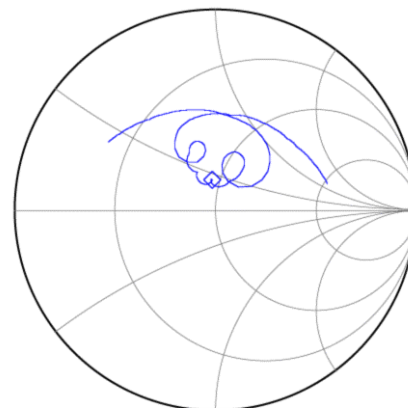
Phase Linearity



Input Smith Chart



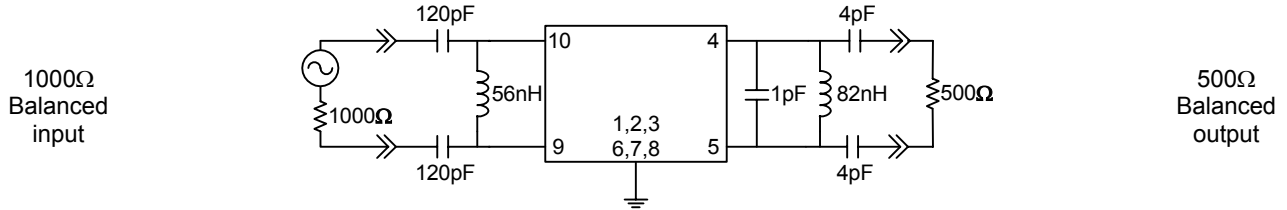
Output Smith Chart



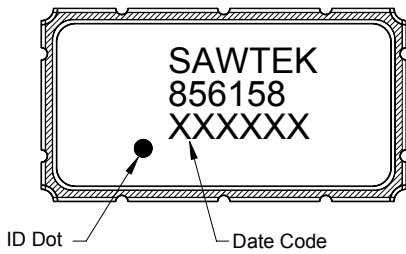

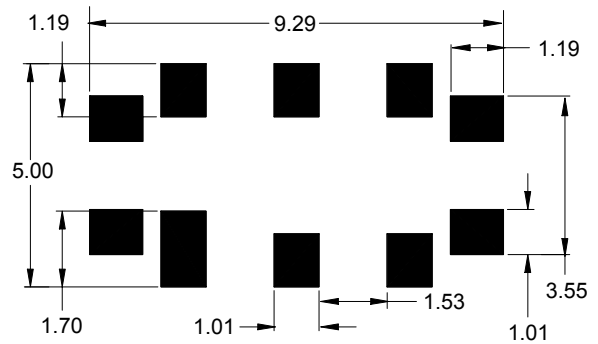
