
 For voltage measurements, a current proportional to the measured voltage must be passed through an external resistor R₁ which is selected by the user and installed in series with the primary circuit of the transducer.

Instructions for use of the voltage transducer model LV 200-AW/2

Primary resistor R₁: the transducer's optimum accuracy is obtained at the nominal primary current. As far as possible, R₁ should be calculated so that the nominal voltage to be measured corresponds to a primary current of 20 mA .

Example: Voltage to be measured $\mathbf{V}_{_{PN}} = 1000 \text{ V}$ a) $\mathbf{R}_{1} = 50 \text{ k}\Omega/40 \text{ W}, \mathbf{I}_{p} = 20 \text{ mA}$
