Product data sheet

#### **General description** 1.

The HEF4001B is a quad 2-input NOR gate. The outputs are fully buffered for the highest noise immunity and pattern insensitivity to output impedance.

It operates over a recommended V<sub>DD</sub> power supply range of 3 V to 15 V referenced to V<sub>SS</sub> (usually ground). Unused inputs must be connected to  $V_{DD},\,V_{SS},\,$  or another input.

The device is suitable for use over both the industrial (-40 °C to +85 °C) and automotive (-40 °C to +125 °C) temperature ranges.

- Fully static operation
- 5 V, 10 V, and 15 V parametric ratings
- Standardized symmetrical output characteristics
- Operates across the automotive temperature range from -40 °C to +125 °C
- Complies with JEDEC standard JESD 13-B









Fig 5. Test circuit for measuring switching times




