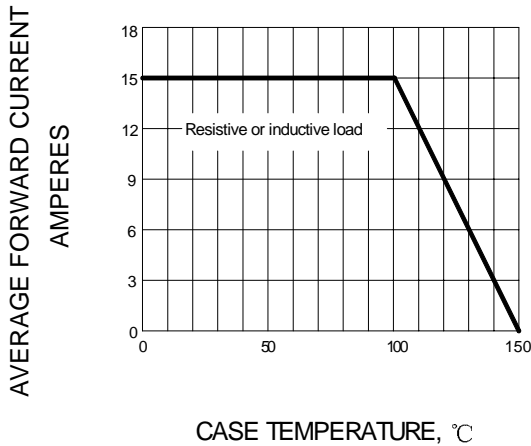

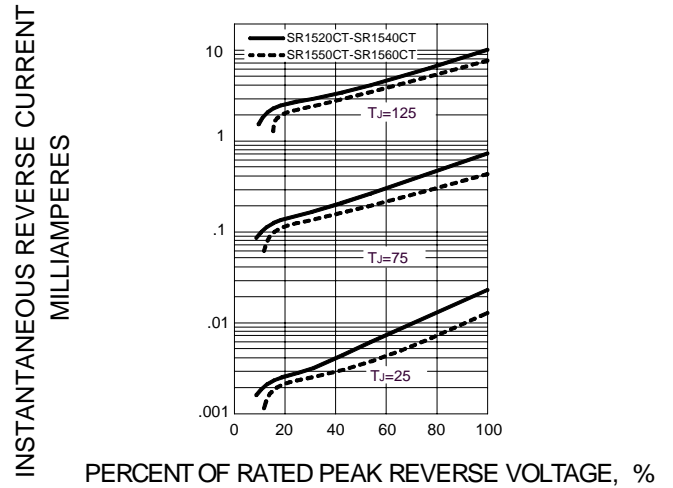

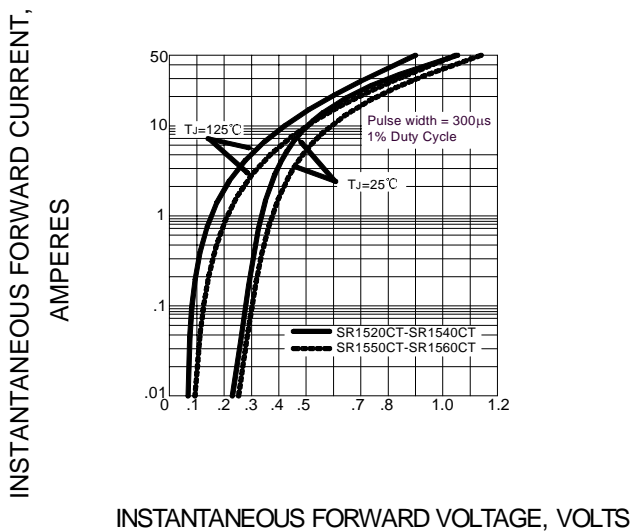
**FIG.1 – FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE**



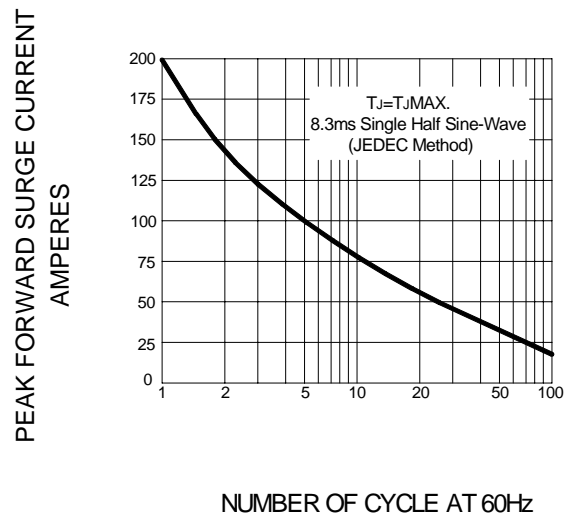
**FIG.2 – TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG**



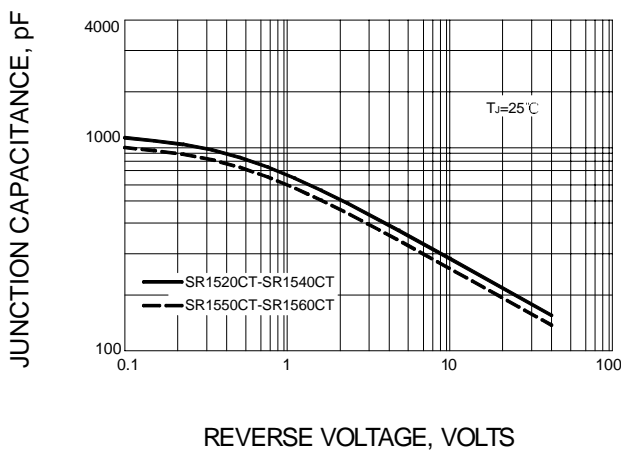
**FIG.3 – TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG**
