# **General Description**








Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics.




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation with temperature.




Figure 5. Transfer Characteristics.




Figure 2. On-Resistance Variation with Drain Current and Gate voltage.




Figure 4. On-Resistance Variation with Gate-to-Source Voltage.





Figure 6. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation with Source Current and Temperature.

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



Figure 7. Gate Charge Characteristics.








Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area.

Figure 10. Single Pulse Maximum Power Dissipation.




Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve.
