


Application Guide USB1.1

Considerations:

- Each port operates at either 1.5Mbps or 12Mbps (low and full speed respectively)
 - → Slower speeds can tolerate higher capacitance devices
- Requires 2 channels of data line protection per port (i.e. D+/D-)
 - ightarrow A 4 channel device can be useful if protecting a USB stack of 2 ports to make the ESD footprint as small as possible
 - → V_{BUS} can be protected separately with a single channel device (0402 shown)
