1. **Product profile**

1.1 General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT78D (TO-220) internally insulated plastic package. This "series ET" triac triac balances the requirements of commutation performance and gate sensitivity and is intended for interfacing with low power drivers including microcontrollers. It is used in applications where "high junction operating temperature" capability is required.

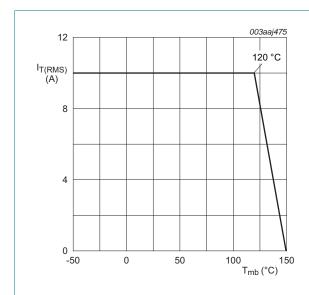
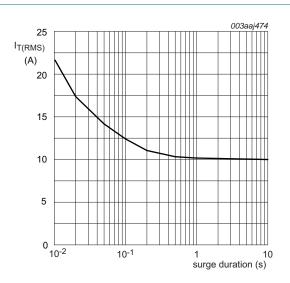


Fig 1. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values

Fig 2. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values

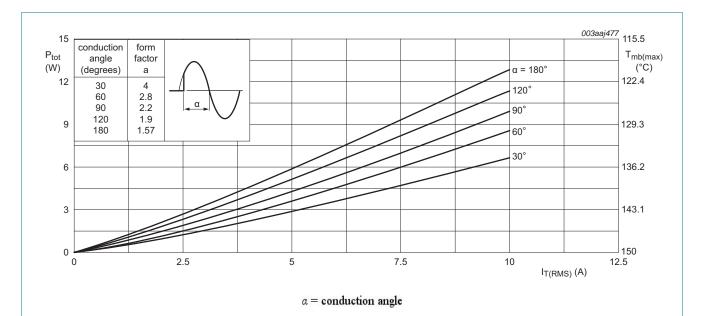
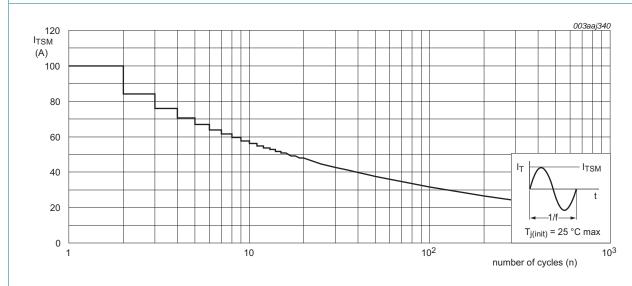
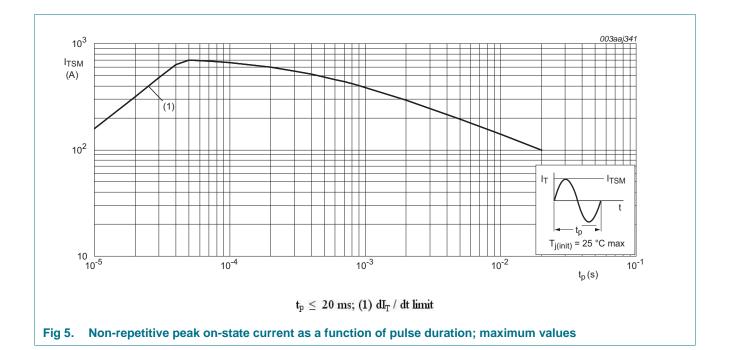


Fig 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values



f = 50 Hz

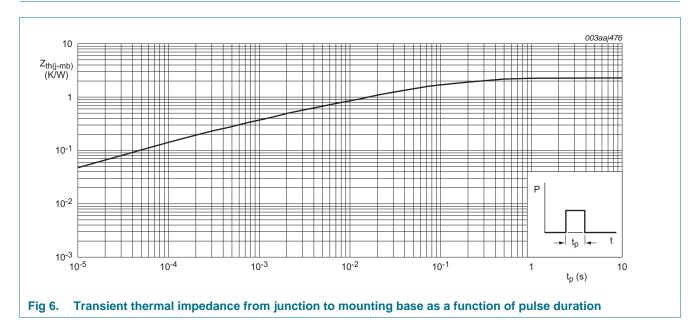
Fig 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values

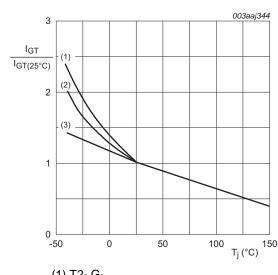

Fig 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature

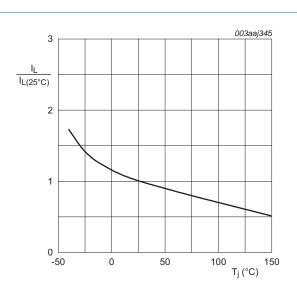
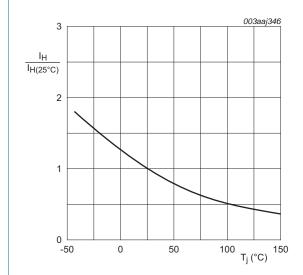
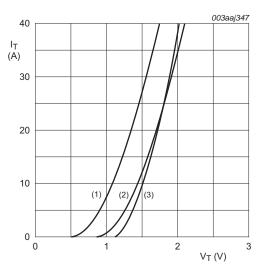


Fig 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature



Normalized holding current as a function of Fig 9. junction temperature



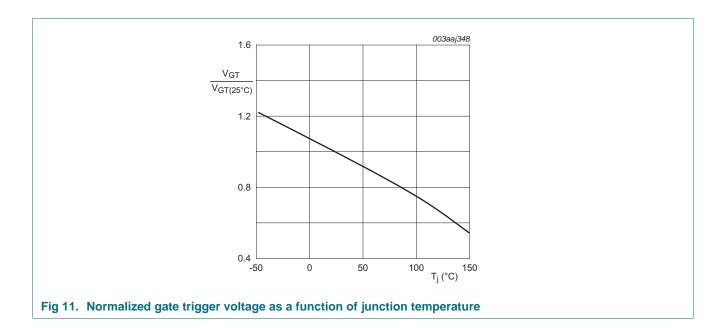

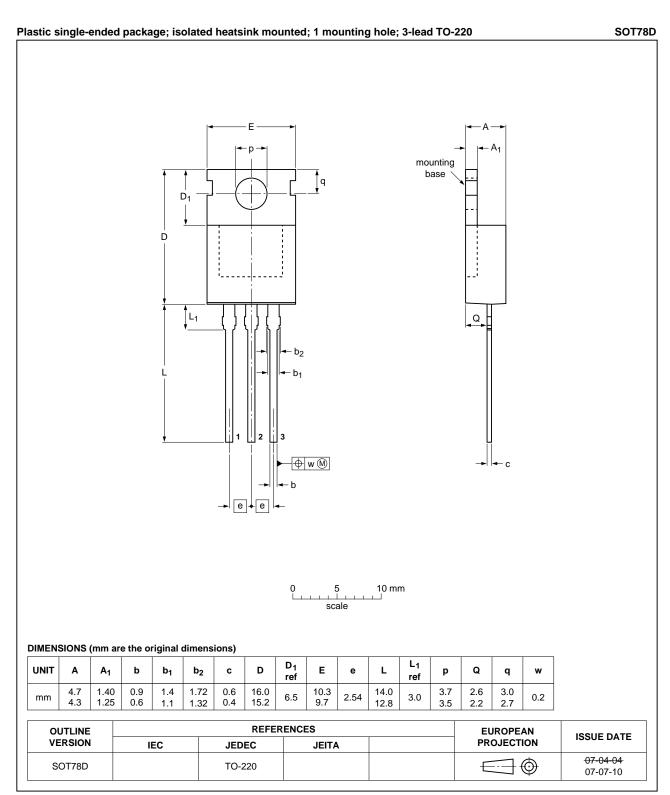


Fig 12. Package outline SOT78D (TO-220AB)
